Somaly Mam

Started by Somaly Mam in 1996:

- -Combat sex-trafficking
- -Care for and rehabilitate victims
- -Vocational Training
- -Reintegration in Society

Founded by Somaly Mam

VISION: A world where human trafficking does not exist.

- -Raise awareness of trafficking locally and globally
- -Fund organisations that rescue, rehabilitate, and reintegrate trafficking victims (such as AFESIP)

Voices for Change

Through media and strategic partnerships, VfC will share the stories, thoughts, and opinions of former slaves. It is a victim centered approach! Ex-victims helping victims.

Voices for Change

- VFC is a subsidiary of the Somaly Mam Foundation
- Run by a team of 4 exvictims: Sina Vann (team leader), Srey Sok Panha, Yon Srey Ka and Srey Lak.
- Each victim was rescued from a brothel and was rehabilitated in an AFESIP shelter.



VFC Objectives

- Combat sexual exploitation of girls through advocacy and awareness raising
- Educate local and provincial government and law enforcement on the issue
- Prevent exploitation and trafficking through direct contact with vulnerable populations

Street children

Girls living near borders

Poor girls in remote areas

- Organise regional and national victim voice committees for victims run by ex-victims
- Provide health and HIV/AIDS education and counseling to victims and girls at risk.

Linklaters - New Day grant

- US\$ 10,167 on 24th September 2008 funded:
- All equipment and furniture for VFC office in Phnom Penh
- 2 motorbikes for team transportation
- Additional training for Sina and women's day celebrations in 3 rehabilitation centers.

- She wants to open her own small business.


A new life...
